



GEEZER-PLEEZER RULES

- ✓ Receive training before you drive.
- ✓ Be sober for your shift.
- ✓ Sign in and out of your shift at Elder Central.
- ✓ GO SLO---5 MPH max
- ✓ No driving inside the Fair from Thursday around 8pm until Monday morning. ABSOLUTELY PROHIBITED TO DRIVE ON JILL'S CROSSING!
- ✓ PAY ATTENTION! Keep your eye on the road, looking out for obstacles and people in your path. Also keep your eye out for folks wanting a ride.
- ✓ Know where you are going. Use the map.
- ✓ Use the radio to contact Elder Central if any questions or issues arise.
- ✓ When finished, return key to designated spot (or to next driver), and sign out.
- ✓ Make sure the Geezer stays charged.
- ✓ The G-P is to be used only for transporting passengers, NO joyriding, personal errands, etc.
