## Geezer Pleezer (G-P) Radio Dispatcher/Elder Central Staffer

Works closely with Geezer on-site Coordinator, Elder Hub Host and Elder Hub Maven to manage two-way radio communications between Elder Central and the drivers and assist with Elder Hub and Camp duties.

The G-P Radio Dispatcher/ElderHub staffer works 2-hour shifts starting Wednesday of Fair until Monday noon. Most shifts are needed Thursday through Sunday. Specific duties

- Coordinates ride requests from Elder Hub, ride requests radioed in from elsewhere and helps with problem solving issues.
- Checks in with G-P driver on a regular basis.
- Assists with Elder Hub security, answers questions, interacts with visitors, and helps manage hospitality.
- Radio communications takes priority over other tasks.

## Qualifications:

Have excellent communication skills and a friendly and fun attitude Be very organized, reliable, courteous and kind First aid training preferred Able to use the radios Be familiar with the routes and Fair Site in general Be available for training prior to first shift Be capable of multi-tasking

## How to get involved:

Monitor the listsery, newsletters, and Facebook for calls for volunteers.

The call usually goes out in April.

Sign up for shifts when the sign-up period begins. Only sign up for 1-2 shifts per day.

Once the Fair is in progress, there is a sign-up sheet at ElderHub and there may be more shifts available.

Let the Geezer on-site coordinator know if you are interested in being back-up dispatcher/staffer.
